

## Guidelines for submitting Photographic works to PanTerra Gallery juried shows

These guidelines are designed around the KISS principle (keep it simple)

4 exhibitions will be juried for the 2008 season.

The exhibitions are as follows with deadlines for submitting work.

### **January 2008 - “ Bisbee 1970 - 2007 Post Mining Era”**

We are looking for photos that tell the stories of the people and place of that era.

**Deadline for submission: November 1, 2007**

### **February 2008 - “What’s Love Got To Do With It?”**

Photos that capture your unique perspective of the concept of “Love” and what it has to do with making us more human.

**Deadline for submission: December 1, 2007**

### **March 2008 - “AZ Asphalt”**

Images made along the highways and byways of Arizona are what this exhibit is all about. They need not be taken actually from a position on the roadside, but should be at least near a road, or perhaps even be about the road itself. It can also be achieved while the vehicle is moving to get the effect of movement (best not to be driving during this exercise). As the name of Arizona's premier scenic magazine attests, many great photographs have fit that category. Do you have one or several?"

**Deadline for submission January 1, 2008**

### **April 2008 - “Bisbee Stairs”**

We are looking for photos that interpret the stairs of Bisbee.

**Deadline for submissions February 1, 2008**

Any photographic method is accepted for exhibition however it is **very important to read the following for submitting work.**

All photographs submitted to the jury must be digitized and emailed to PanTerra Gallery at [info@panterragallery.com](mailto:info@panterragallery.com)

**No work will be accepted through the mail or delivered to the Gallery.**

All levels and age groups are welcome to participate in the jury process.

If work is accepted for exhibition you will be required to accept the standard Gallery contract.
